Since 1973, the San Luis Obispo Mothers for Peace (MFP) has played a unique role in pressuring federal regulators to do a better job of protecting the safety of the environment and the population downwind from the Diablo Canyon nuclear plant. This includes safeguarding the radioactive wastes accumulating at the plant since 1984, which will remain lethal for 250,000 years. This group of local citizens has obtained the services of the best attorneys and expert witnesses in the nation to force the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to protect public safety more vigorously than it protects corporate profits.

MFP believes that we owe it to future generations and to the environment to continue this role of nuclear guardianship.
