The challenge of permanent and safe storage of high-level radioactive waste from nuclear power plants has long been the Achilles' heel of the industry. The NRC has long reiterated that it has "confidence" that a solution will be forthcoming.

In June of 2012, however, the U.S. Court of Appeals in D.C. challenged this "confidence" and has required the NRC to study the environmental impacts of storing spent fuel indefinitely in either pools or dry casks. The NRC has responded with a "hurry-up" two-year timeframe for environmental review. The NRC's own staff has estimated that the data collecting and analysis would require seven years.

On November 20, you have an opportunity to attend an NRC meeting in San Luis Obispo and speak your mind. Let the NRC know how you feel about their plan to store highly radioactive waste on our seismically active coastline for the next 300 years.
