

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is coming to San Luis Obispo on Wednesday, November 28. **Join the Mothers for Peace at this important meeting.**

The NRC will present its assessment of Pacific Gas and Electric Company's (PG&E's) Shoreline Fault Report, developed early in 2011. PG&E is in the midst of a 3-year study of the seismic hazards to the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant posed by many nearby earthquake faults. The Shoreline Report focuses on assurances that the plant is safe, without reference to alternate views or the levels of uncertainty in the work of its own scientists.

The topics of this meeting include:

1. "Report on the Analysis of the Shoreline Fault Zone"
