MFP is intervening at the Public Utilities Commission to shut down the plant by 2019. That would spare us five years of Russian Roulette -- the risk of an earthquake, human error, mechanical failure, or a terrorist attack.

Diablo Canyon is currently storing over 4.5 million pounds of highly radioactive waste on our earthquake fault-ridden coastline. Every day that the plant runs, it produces 500 more pounds of this waste with nowhere to go. The radioactive waste – the legacy of nuclear power – is Duane's main concern.

We already have expert testimony (which you can access through our home page). Now we need to raise additional funds for work by our attorney and expert witnesses, as well as expenses for the April CPUC hearings in San Francisco.
